Health and Safety reminder

Christmas in school information

- Christmas parties: Children may come to school dressed in their party clothes on the day of their party.
 Please bear in mind that they will still be outside at playtimes and lunchtimes, so will need to wear warm layers and suitable footwear. They will have party food and you will be sent a Google Form to sign up for party food donations. Please remember that all donations need to be nut-free and should be sent into school with your child on the day of the party.
- Christmas cards: there is no obligation for your child to write cards for their class, but we know that lots of children do like to do so. These can be posted in our school Post Box in the entrance area and will then be delivered to the classes by Year 6 children. Please remember to add the child's name and class.
