All schools in England will be required to administer statutory assessments in specific year groups again this year. The table below is a reminder of when, and for whom, these tests are applicable.

	Friday 12 th May	Maths (arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving)

I would encourage all parents to attend in order that you can best support your child in preparation for their SATS.

For parents of children in Year 1/2 and 4, the upcoming check for your child will be discussed in the Spring Parents' evening and staff will be happy to answer any questions that you might have.

We always tell the children that these checks/ tests are an opportunity to celebrate their learning and not something to worry about.
