Can you child think of any words that have these sounds in? Can they write a list of the words containing these sounds or write some sentences with these sounds in?

Can your child identify this number? Can they count out the correct number of objects? Can they count on and back from this number? Can they tell you one more / one less? Can they find this number in the environment? How many different ways can they add together 2, 3 or 4 numbers to total this amount? Eq: 10+3=13, 5+5+3=13, 5+4+3+1=13. Can they make this amount using coins?
