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## English Tasks



1. Spelling Shed Activities: Login on 'Seesaw' and click 'Activities' to access some reading and writing activities featuring this week spelling rule: 'The long vowel 'i' spelled with a y'. Click on the icon and this will take you directly to the log-in page. Once you have completed each book, don't forget to complete the quiz to see how many questions you can get correct.
