How can I support my child in maths at home?

We often get asked this question and for the vast majority of our children, the answer is simple... get them to go on **TTRockstars** for 10 minutes at least three times a week! This will give them enough dedicated time to significantly improve their quick recall of times tables. This is so important as times tables are fundamental to many maths topics. When children recall times tables quickly, it frees up their working memory allowing them to develop their reasoning skills.



All the staff regularly promote TTRockstars in school and we celebrate success in our Friday assemblies, but we are still finding that not enough children are accessing this resource at home. Here are a few tips...

- Ensure that you are using the latest version of the app and website to ensure they receive the most secure, feature-rich and enjoyable experience of Times Tables Rock Stars. Some of the versions are so far behind that your child will missing out on key updates. If using the website at home, please visit <u>play.ttrockstars.com/reset</u> to load the latest version in your browser or update the Times Tables Rock Stars app from the app store.
- Ensure your child has gone on the website at **least three times per week across the week** the earlier the better.
- Ensure that they practise in the "garage" section to complete their ten games before practising in other areas.

Year 6 Restorative Ambassadors

Restorative approaches are at the heart of life at Queensgate as it describes a way of being, an underpinning ethos, which enables us to build and maintain healthy relationships, resolve difficulties and repair harm when relationships breakdown.
