Education Penalty Notices

We recently met with our Education Welfare Officer from the local authority to review our attendance data. Whilst the the overall attendance for the school is very positive and above local and national averages, we were reminded that a fine (Education Penalty Notice) should be issued to parent/s every time there are 10 or more sessions (i.e. **5 school days**) of unauthorised absence.

Last year we did have a number of term-time holiday requests as they were holidays that had been re-arranged/postponed due to COVID. This is no longer the case and term time holidays requests have been unauthorised. In line with local authority guidance, from Monday 31st October we will be asking the local authority to issue a fine whenever there are 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence.

PTA

The PTA Spooky disco was very much enjoyed by the children last night and we are very grateful to the parents that stepped forward to make the event possible.

I can't stress enough how important the funds raised for the PTA will be to Queensgate this year. After 12 years of being a Headteacher, I have never known a time when the school's budget has been stretched to the point it is currently. It is not sustainable and already very difficult decisions are having to be taken to provide the very best education that we can for our children. Due to the context of our school (very low area of deprivation), we do not qualify for significant amounts of funding or support. The PTA is one of our very few sources of additional funding and we greatly appreciate it. Please continue to support our PTA in any way that you can.

If your child is in Year 1 – Year 6, they will be bringing home a Learning Postcard this week as a short piece of holiday Home Learning.
