At Queensgate Primary School, we follow the statutory exclusion guidance issued by the Department for Education (DfE) when making decisions regarding exclusion from school and carrying out the exclusion process.

The current version of the DfE exclusion guidance '**Suspension and Permanent Exclusion from maintained schools, academies and pupil referral units in England, including pupil movement: Guidance for maintained schools, academies, and pupil referral units in England**' can be found on the school exclusion page of the Gov.uk website: <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/school-exclusion>

All maintained schools in England must have regard to this guidance when carrying out their functions in relation to exclusions. The phrase 'must have regard', when used in this context, means that everyone involved in the exclusion process at Queensgate Primary School will follow the sections of statutory guidance unless there is a good reason not to in a particular case, in which case the reason must be justified.
